Empowering SHGs: Unlocking Opportunities through GeM Portal

Focusing on the onboarding of Self-Help Groups products on the Government e-Marketplace (GeM) Portal, a training & handholding session was organised by Assam State Urban Livelihoods Mission at Guwahati. The GeM portal offers SHG women



new opportunities to engage in public procurement. The training sessions included a comprehensive overview of the GeM portal, guiding the SHG women through the registration process, vendor categorization, product and service listing, order management, quality compliance, payment procedures, etc. This initiative aimed to provide SHG women the confidence to look into new business prospects and boost their economic development. A total of 40 SHG women entrepreneurs, engaged in different quality products and nodal persons of seller points participated in the training.

Empowering Dreams and Creating Fashion: Magic Tailor: An inspiring story

This is an inspiring success story of a young and inspiring businesswoman, Anjali Jha, who is making waves in the world of fashion with her designer tailor studio, 'Imagination 99 Studio', located in Laxmi Vihar Burari, Delhi. With the assistance of the Self-Employment Programme of DAY-NULM, she secured a loan of ₹ 2 lakh, which served as the foundation for her business. This support not only helped her to establish the boutique but also created livelihood opportunities for other women in her locality. By creating livelihood opportunities for other women, she is setting an example for other entrepreneurs and instilling a spirit of entrepreneurship in her surroundings.









Pesingi Satish, Fast Food Cart, (Kakinada, Andhra Pradesh)

Satish, applied for PM SVANidhi loan of ₹10,000 when his fast-food joint business was not doing well. After facing harassment from private money lenders and no capital left to restart his business, PM SVANidhi scheme came as a boon to him and his family. With the capital received, he restarted his business and was soon able to recover all the losses. He also started doing digital transactions with the QR code and has earned cashback. He repaid the 1st loan within a year and received an interest subsidy of ₹402. Subsequently, he availed 2nd loan of ₹20,000/. He is also a registered vendors with Swiggy under SVAD (Swadisht Vyanjan ki Adhunik Dukaan) and he is able to reach out to new customers with home delivery offered by Swiggy. He got himself enrolled for PM Suraksha Bima Yojana, PM Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana and ONORC schemes under SVANidhi Se Samriddhi initiative. He plans to further expand his operations by availing the third loan of ₹50,000/.
