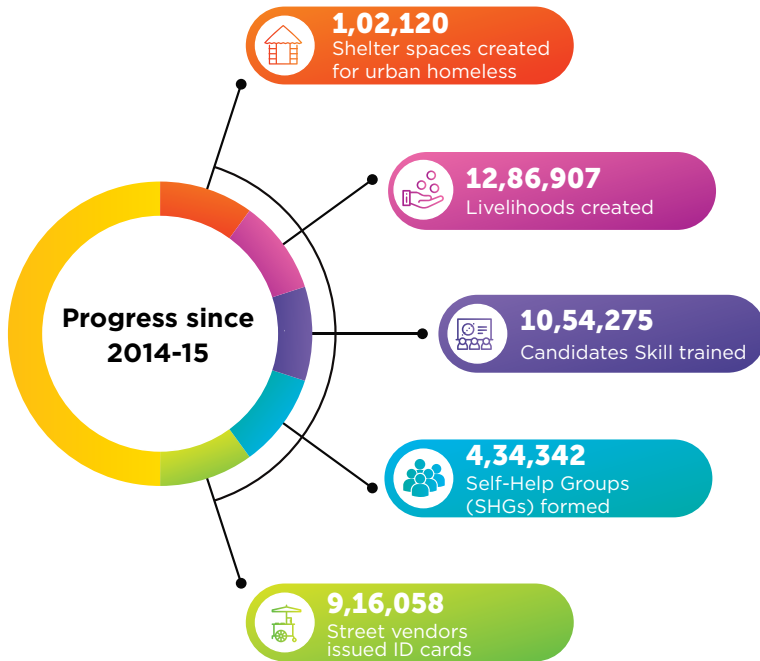

VC WITH THE NER STATES

A Video Conference was held on February 11, 2020, under the chairmanship of Shri Sanjay Kumar, Joint Secretary & Mission Director, with the North East Region states to review the progress of the mission and activities under *Shehri Samriddhi Utsav - 2020*.



HANDS-ON TRAINING ORGANISED

One-day orientation programmes and hands-on training in regard to on-boarding of products made by Self-Help Groups on the Flipkart e-commerce platform were organized in various states viz. Gujarat, Goa, Puducherry, Tamil Nadu, Uttarakhand, Manipur and Mizoram. The programmes were participated by the ULB officials, Mission Managers, nodal officers and women Self-Help Group members.

REVIEW OF URBAN MISSIONS

Shri Durga Shanker Mishra, Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) reviewed the status of implementation of urban missions in Uttar Pradesh on February 14, 2020, at Lucknow. The meeting was participated by the Principal Secretary, Secretaries, Directors, Programme Officers and other senior officers in-charge of implementation of the missions in the state.





MODEL SHELTER INAUGURATED

On February 5, 2020, Shri Dibya Sankar Mishra, Hon'ble Minister, Energy, Industries, Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises and Home Affairs (State Minister), Government of Odisha inaugurated a newly constructed model shelter for urban homeless in Rourkela. The 50 bedded shelter is equipped with various facilities.

HEALTH CAMP FOR SHELTER RESIDENTS

On February 1, 2020, free health check-up camps for the shelter residents were organized by the Public Health Department at 51 shelters run by the Greater Chennai Corporation. Free medicines including supplements for nutritional deficiencies were also distributed to the residents during the camps.



AMMA RUCHI:FOOD ON WHEELS LAUNCHED

Amma Ruchi - Food on wheels, an enterprise serving food ensuring cleanliness and hygiene was launched in Kalamassery Municipality, Kerala. The kitchens with modern technology are fixed in electric vehicles with solar panels. A total of 15 SHG women were given training in driving, cooking, customer management, and service to manage 3 units of 'food on wheel kitchen'.

ORIENTATION PROGRAMME ON USAGE OF MOBILE APP ON SUSV

An orientation programme & hands-on training, on methods of collection of information on various activities carried out by ULBs under the Mission component of Support to Urban Street Vendors by using the mobile app, was organised on February 7, 2020 at MEPMA office, Andhra Pradesh. The objective of programme was to identify best performing ULBs in implementing the Street Vendor Act 2014 and Support to Urban Street Vendor component. A total of 135 data entry operators, IT anchor persons of 110 ULBs participated in the programme.



CAPACITY BUILDING TRAINING ORGANISED

A two-day sensitisation programme, under the Integrated Capacity Building Training program (ICBP), was organized from February 13-14, 2020 at Indian Institute of Public Administration, Delhi. The programme was participated by 20 elected representatives of Municipal Corporation and Councils from the State of Bihar.



EXHIBITION OF SHG PRODUCTS

On February 6, 2020, a day-long exhibition-cum sale of products made by Self-Help Groups was organised by Assam State Urban Livelihoods Mission at Guwahati Medical College Auditorium. A total of 55 women SHGs exhibited their products covering handicraft, handloom, jewellery, eatables, organic food, and home décor etc.



AWARENESS-CUM-CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAMME ON STREET VENDING

On February 11, 2020, an awareness-cum-capacity building programme on Street Vendors Act and Chandigarh Street Vending Bye-laws was organised at Chandigarh Police Auditorium for Police and Traffic officers including Station House Officers and DSPs.
