Video conference with States



Shri Sanjay Kumar, Joint Secretary & Mission Director (NULM) conducted two VCs, on January 4 & 9, 2019 to review the progress for *Shehri Samridhi Utsav*. The States were impressed upon to complete the survey for strengthening urban safety net to identify the beneficiaries for facilitating their access to relevant government schemes. States were also asked to share details of activities ULB-wise, in the format shared by the Ministry.

Stakeholder consultation

Construction sector has been identified as one of the champion sectors having high employment potential & MoHUA has been designated as liaise ministry. A stakeholder consultation was organised, under the Chairmanship of Joint Secretary (NULM) on January 7, 2019 to get the feedback on the proposed scheme design.

Maharashtra: 29 SHGs of Vasai-Virar participated in the Konkan Festival Exhibition, held on January 11-14, 2019, to showcase and sell their handloom & handicraft products, including imitation jewellery, home decor items, packaged food products and eatables.



Telangana: 70 SHGs of MEPMA, participated in the *79th All India Industrial Exhibition* at Hyderabad where they displayed items made by them which include *sarees*, embroidery, *zardaus*i garments and eatables etc.

Chandigarh: Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh in association with Tech Mahindra Smart Academy for Health Care organized a workshop, on January 10, 2019, to sensitise urban SHGs and their federations on 'Women Empowerment and Domestic Violence'. The workshop was attended by 95 SHG members.

Rajasthan: On January 5, 2019, Identity cards along with the garbage bins, were distributed to 355 identified street vendors in Jalore. The vendors were also sensitised about cleanliness, hygiene and traffic rules.

Tamil Nadu: To promote livelihoods for shelter residents Greater Chennai Corporation (GCC) has taken an initiative under which, by organising exhibitions on every Friday to enable the shelter inmates to showcase and sell their items such as food stuffs, organic products, paper bags, candles, flowers etc.


