

Skill India Mission

A job fair was organized at CPIT Skills Education, Hajipur, Bihar. Over 100 candidates participated and 55 candidates got job placements. Employers include Eureka Forbes, Shiv Shakti Biotech, Prabhat Trust and others

An awareness programme was organized for Skill Training Providers and candidates on 30th May 2018, on the Personalized After Training Rapid Assessment System (PARAS) at Gumla, Jharkhand. PARAS is a feedback mechanism through SMS for candidates who have completed training. PARAS was introduced to improve monitoring of training quality.



Shelters for the Urban Homeless

GIS based third party systematic survey was completed in 20 ULBs of Telangana, identifying more than 3500 urban homeless persons. The survey results will be used to estimate the requirements and operationalize the required shelters for urban homeless in these Telangana cities.

Night Bazaar was organized at Imphal, Manipur, from 26th -27th May 2018. Self Help Groups participated enthusiastically in the Bazaar and showcased their products.



Self Employment Program

day Entrepreneurship Development Program (EDP) was organized at Kulu, Himachal Pradesh for 27 candidates. Many of the candidates have got loans sanctioned for their micro-enterprises. The EDP program covered business establishment and strategy, marketing, copmepetion, branding, accounts management and communication skills.



Support for Urban Street Vendors

Street vendors in Hamirpur and Sujanpur municipal councils of Himachal Pradesh were trained on legal rights, hygienic practices, health and safety aspects at a workshop from 16th - 18th May 2018.

Convergence

Qualification Packs for various job roles in sanitation sector are being developed, with a particular focus on Fecal Sludge and Septage Management (FSSM). The objective is to promote skill development in FSSM sector, leading to dignified livelihood and employment opportunities along the sanitation value chain.

A stakeholder workshop was organized to seek industry validation for the FSSM Qualification Packs, on May 31, 2018 at New Delhi in coordination with the Sector Council for Green Jobs.
