

A Tale of Resilience & Community Empowerment Soorya's Fresh Start



n the quiet residential area of Kudappanakunnu, Trivandrum, Soorya, a homemaker and dedicated member of **Pulari SHG**, transformed her life during the pandemic. With her husband, a driver facing increased pressure, they seized the opportunity to address the local demand for fresh fish. Starting small, they soon expanded their venture, **Kamala Fresh**, into a thriving microenterprise with multiple branches.

Using savings and a loan under the SEP component of DAY-NULM, they built a dedicated store and sourced fish from Vizhinjam and Kollam harbors. Community support was overwhelming, and Soorya's entrepreneurial spirit flourished. She invested an initial amount for her operations and additionally secured a loan of ₹2,00,000 through SEP.

Her team included neighbours, relatives, and trusted contacts, all fairly compensated, ensuring a motivated workforce. **Kamala Fresh** maintained sustainability with a monthly budget of ₹20,000 and nine dedicated employees. Facing challenges, Soorya showcased adaptability by distributing surplus fish, minimizing losses, and reinforcing community goodwill.

Soorya's journey is a testament to resilience, determination, and community spirit, improving her family's financial situation and creating a positive impact on her community through Kamala Fresh.

stablished on July 16, 2019, in Bethlehem Vengthlang, Aizawl, Mizoram, the all-women **Nuihiau SHG** began with seven members aiming to improve their livelihoods and achieve collective goals. The group initiated various income-generating activities, such as raw noodle production, candle making, and dry chili flakes production. Under NULM, they have received subsidised credit linkages of ₹8.50 lakhs under SEP-G.

Initially, the members were homemakers with no regular income. The group's activities have provided extra earnings, improving their family finances. Participation in DAY-NULM Skill Training Programmes has equipped them with new skills, enhancing their capabilities and confidence. The SEP-G loans have also facilitated internal lending, supporting individual ventures.

Committed to social responsibility, **Nuihiau SHG** engages in charitable activities annually on their Rising Day, donating gifts to Children's Homes. Their journey from homemakers to successful entrepreneurs highlights the transformative power of self-help groups. Through strategic use of loans, skill development, and social responsibility, they have uplifted their lives and contributed positively to their community, serving as an inspiring model for other women and SHGs seeking economic empowerment.

She promoted SHG-made products like toys, bags, clothes through door-to-door marketing. These efforts not only provided her with a steady income of ₹12,000 to ₹14,000 per month but also empowered those around her.

Sapna's hard work and dedication did not go unnoticed. The Deputy Commissioner of Chamba commended her for her professionalism and commitment to public service. Through her efforts, she transformed her circumstances, securing a stable income and nurturing her family with dignity. n Nahan City, Himachal Pradesh, Ms. Rehnuma Praveen's life took a painful turn due to an abusive marriage, forcing her to seek refuge with her daughters at her parents' home. Struggling as a single mother abandoned by her husband, she toiled as a housemaid for a decade to support her family. Joining the **Awa Sheen SHG**under the DAY-NULM scheme in January 2022 offered her a newfound ray of hope. Here, she discovered not just financial empowerment, but a supportive community that uplifted her spirits and provided growth opportunities.

Working at a women's night shelter through the Awa Sheen SHG, Rehnuma found purpose and stability, through her stable income. This didn't just sustain her family but allowed her to contribute to society by caring for other women in need. Her dedication didn't go unnoticed, and her remarkable journey from hardship to triumph landed her the prestigious 'Nari tu Narayani' award organised by Himachal Dastak (media news channel) in 2023. Rehnuma's story epitomizes resilience, empowerment, and the transformative impact of supportive initiatives like the DAY-NULM scheme and community-driven efforts.

From Mud Stoves to Success

Ekta Mahila SHG's Empowering Journey



n the heart of Karnal city's Ram Nagar area, a group of determined women once struggled over mud stoves and tandoors to make ends meet. In 2016, they were united by the DAY-NULM, Karnal unit, to form the **Ekta Mahila Swayam Sahayata Samooh**. Despite initial resistance from their families, accustomed to borrowing from moneylenders at high interest rates, these women persisted in forming a SHG to save and provide internal loans.

Starting with a modest monthly contribution of ₹100 per member, they began their journey toward financial independence. Today, each member contributes ₹500 monthly. 11 out of the 12 members are illiterate, yet their solidarity strengthened during the COVID-19 pandemic. Supporting each other without resorting to external loans, the group utilized a ₹10,000 revolving fund and diligently followed the Panchasutras. Now, all the women have learned to write their names, and none relies on external loans.

Their story is a testament to the power of unity and determination, showing how a group of women transformed their lives through mutual support and financial discipline.

Today, **Ekta Mahila Swayam Sahayata Samooh** saves ₹6,000 monthly, earning significant interest and transforming lives of the members. Their handmade tandoors are now in demand in Karnal and neighbouring cities. Inspired by their success, 26 more SHGs have been formed in Ram Nagar, creating a community where women uplift each other and write their own success stories.

This empowered the women to launch an organic compost business in Gotri Garden, fostering economic self-sufficiency and sustainability.

In the year 2024, Navkar Sakhi Mandal has been allotted Operations and Maintenance work of a park under AMRUT Mitra project with a monthly project cost of ₹70,000. Not only Navkar SHG have played an important role in maintenance of the AMRUT Mitra Project under convergence with AMRUT Mission but also trained SHG named Sitaram Sakhi Mandal whose few members are incorporated for the maintenance of the park. Navkar Sakhi Mandal exemplifies how determination, support, and hard work foster financial independence and enrich communities, inspiring others to achieve similar feats.

n Gariaband, Chhattisgarh, the Jai Kishan SHG has become a beacon of empowerment and resilience. Formed under the DAY-NULM Scheme in September 2017, this group of 11 women, previously engaged in manual labor, came together with a shared vision of transforming their lives and community.

Pooling their resources and leveraging their entrepreneurial spirit, the members of **Jai Kishan SHG** ventured into a catering business, catering to a wide array of events from birthdays to government functions. Their dedication and hard work soon garnered them and contracts from various government departments, including health, forest, and electricity, as well as the local Municipality.

Their success story didn't halt during the challenging times of COVID-19. Instead, **Jai Kishan SHG** stepped up, providing essential food services to patients and staff at the Gariaband COVID Hospital, delivering over a hundred meals daily, priced affordably to meet the hospital's requirements.

Recently, their journey reached a new milestone with the inauguration of 'Kishan Mahila Swa Sahayta Samooh Restaurant' within the Gariaband Municipality, marking another achievement in their pursuit of economic independence and community upliftment.

Supported by the DAY-NULM Scheme and the Union Bank of India, **Jai Kishan SHG's** journey exemplifies the transformative impact of collective action and government support. Their story not only inspires but also underscores the potential of women-led initiatives to bring about lasting social and economic change.

Wheels of Change

Pink Auto Initiative



n Bongaigaon, Assam, a transformative initiative called the **Pink Auto** was launched by Bongaigaon Municipal Board under DAY-NULM. Aimed at providing safe commuting for women while creating livelihood opportunities, this project brought together like-minded women to form a SHG named **Nobo Prohor**.

The journey began with identifying 10 prospective women auto drivers. These women, previously working as domestic workers or running small tea shops, faced the daunting challenge of funding customized autos and receiving proper training. The CMMU, with sponsorship from Bongaigaon Refineries (now Indian Oil Corporation Limited) not only agreed to support the Caution Money Deposit but decided to fully fund 10 three-wheeler autos.

The women of **Nobo Prohor**, jubilant with this unexpected support, decided to create a corpus fund for the recurring expenses and maintenance of their vehicles. They committed to depositing a portion of their monthly earnings into their SHG account, ensuring sustainability.

The **Pink Auto** initiative was officially launched in January 2018. Since its inception, the women drivers have thrived, earning as much as their male counterparts and providing a safe, private mode of transport for women in Bongaigaon.

Pink Auto has become an essential service for school and college students, working women, single mothers, and older women. The community has shown immense support and respect for these brave women, who have not only ensured safety for female passengers but also carved out sustainable livelihoods for themselves. The success of the Pink Auto initiative stands as a testament to the power of community-driven efforts and the impact of supportive programmes like DAY-NULM in transforming lives and empowering women.

Transforming Public Amenities *Pink Toilet Bus Initiative*



n Gorakhpur, Uttar Pradesh, an innovative project by the Municipal Corporation is transforming public amenities with a focus on women's welfare. What was once a regular Uttar Pradesh Roadways bus is now a Pink Toilet Bus and Confectionary Store, setting a new standard for urban sanitation and community services.

Following the theme of Reduce, Reuse, Recycle (RRR), the Pink Toilet Bus caters specifically to women and families in Nauka Vihar of Gorakhpur district. It features feeding areas for nursing mothers, three regular toilets, one Western toilet, handwashing facilities, and a confectionary store. Solar panels on the roof ensure uninterrupted electricity, and two 500-liter water tanks support water management.

This pioneering project is a significant collaborative effort with local women's self-help group like **Kripa SHG** under DAY-NULM. These groups play a crucial role in implementing and managing the pink bus's operations, marking a milestone in community-driven urban development.

Currently, two Pink Toilet Buses are in service in Gorakhpur, integrating practical amenities with environmental consciousness. Equipped with basins, mirrors, and ample water storage, this initiative sets a precedent for similar projects across Uttar Pradesh, showcasing the power of innovation and community collaboration in addressing urban challenges.

The Tale of Prefab Libraries for Knowledge Building



n the heart of Cuttack's bustling streets, a quiet revolution is unfolding in the form of pre-fabricated smart libraries, a haven of knowledge and hope for many slum dwellers. These libraries, strategically set up by the Cuttack Municipal Corporation across eight locations including Krushak Bazar, Dhabaleswar, Judge Pada, Nimpur, Laxmanpur, Jagatpur, Bali Sahi, and Nuapatna, are not just buildings but beacons of opportunity for the city's slum dwellers. These libraries are managed by 8 SHGs in 8 locations.

For many slum students, these libraries have become a sanctuary, a place where they can escape the challenges of their daily lives and immerse themselves in the world of learning. The cost of setting up the Prefab Library is borne by Cuttack Municipal Corporation. Each library is equipped with a dedicated librarian and a caretaker, while the library operations are overseen by a local SHG. There are two staff members deployed by SHGs: one librarian and one security guard. The supervision cost is paid to SHGs by Cuttack Municipal Corporation.

Indeed, the impact of these prefab libraries extends far beyond literacy. They have become catalysts for change, creating an educational atmosphere that thrives on curiosity and aspiration. Through these humble libraries, Cuttack is rewriting the narrative for its slum communities—empowering them with knowledge, igniting their imaginations, and paving the way for a brighter future.

n the bustling streets of her hometown, Sangita Ramteke's journey from managing a small scrap shop to running multiple waste collection centres is a testament to resilience and entrepreneurial spirit. A single mother of two, Sangita faced significant challenges, particularly due to her husband's alcoholism. With only a ninth-grade education, she shouldered the responsibility of supporting her household from a young age.

Sangita found herself at a crossroads after her husband's passing in 2019, Determined to create a better life for her children, she ventured into the waste collection and recycling business. What began as a small endeavour soon grew into a thriving enterprise. Collaborating with **Savitri Bai Mahila Bachat Gat**, she collected, segregated, and packed garbage for sale to various agents. Her hard work and determination bore fruit, enabling her to provide her children with higher education, and eventually purchase a new house and a four-wheeler.

Today, this SHG under the leadership of Sangita manages a Municipal Corporation-run Material Recovery Facility (MRF) waste collection center and two personal garbage collection centers. SHG employs five women and five men directly in her business, while over 50 other garbage collectors sell their waste at centers daily, supporting their livelihoods. Collecting approximately 1000 kg of solid waste daily, Sangita and her team meticulously segregate it into 16-17 different types before selling it to recycling companies. This business generates around ₹12 lakh annually. SHG's success through Sangita's leadership underscores the power of determination, community support, and sustainable practices in transforming adversity into triumph.

She began taking small orders from local vendors and delivering products door-to-door with the help of SHG members.

In September 2023, Rita and her SHG secured a ₹1,00,000 loan under the SEP of DAY-NULM, sanctioned by Assam Gramin Vikash Bank. This allowed her to employ fellow SHG members in spice production and sales. By April 2024, the SHG under the leadership of Rita, had obtained an additional ₹2,49,000 loan under the PMFME Scheme from Union Bank, Tinsukia, enabling her to buy a larger spice grinding machine. With increased production capacity, she began supplying spices to local shops and markets and obtained a food safety license to enhance her business's credibility.

The ULB provided Rita and other SHG members with valuable training, and the State HQ offered additional support. These initiatives, combined with financial assistance, transformed Rita's life. She broke free from poverty, created employment for others, and achieved economic stability.

This venture quickly proved successful, with the SHG's earnings witnessing a substantial increase within months. Their participation in exhibitions and community events further bolstered sales and promoted sustainable practices.

Today, members of **SATLUZ SHG** earn an additional amount upto ₹10,000 rupees monthly, supplementing their incomes from street vending. These vending spaces also advertise about the organic compost which has resulted in huge demand for the organic compost. The story of SATLUZ SHG exemplifies how collaborative efforts can create meaningful opportunities, transform livelihoods, and foster community resilience through sustainable practices.

Encouraged by her initial success, Vasanthi repaid the loan and applied for a second tranche of ₹20,000 to buy storage boxes for her vegetables.

Her business grew steadily, and after repaying the second loan, Vasanthi applied for a third tranche of ₹50,000. She used this money to buy a four-wheel pushcart and other essential items. Learning about a ₹2 lakh SEP loan under DAY-NULM, she approached the Mulki Town Panchayat office. With the loan sanctioned by Canara Bank Mulki, Vasanthi purchased a three-wheeler auto to sell her vegetables and coconuts more efficiently.

Utilizing a QR code for digital payments, Vasanthi has streamlined her business operations, reducing the hassle of handling cash.
