### **Inauguration of CLC- Assam**

A City Livelihoods Centre, which is second in the state, was inaugurated at Nagaon, Assam on July 10, 2019, by Shri Rupak Sharma, Hon'ble MLA. It will act as a `one-stop-shop' for those seeking services from the informal sector as well as for the urban poor promoting their services and products.







## Social Audit undertaken - Chennai

The Greater Chennai Corporation has started social audit of shelters in the city. The Shelter Advisory Committee chaired by City Health Officer undertook visit of shelters on July 15, 2019. Besides interacting with the residents to record their feedback, the audit would also cover related issues including infrastructure facilities provided, and behaviour of staff towards residents.



## Financial Literacy Training-Gujarat

To create awareness among the SHG members on Digital payments, the National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI), in association with SULM, organised a training programme, from July 9-10, 2019 at Arogya Bhawan, Ahmedabad. Demonstration of Digital payment products i.e. BHIM App was also made to the participants. 231 women SHG members participated in the training.



## SHELTERS SANCTIONED IN KARNATAKA

The 9th meeting of Project Sanctioning Committee, held at Bengaluru on July 5, 2019, approved a total of 59 proposals for construction/refurbishment / 0&M cost of shelters and setting up of Vending Zones. Total cost of projects approved was Rs. 676.53 lakh Conducting third party systematic survey for identification of urban homeless in all ULBs was also approved.

## FINANCIAL LITERACY COUNSELLING AND HEALTH CAMP - CHANDIGARH

The State Urban Poverty Alleviation Cell (SUPA), Chandigarh organized a Financial Literacy Camp which was attended by 47 urban poor beneficiaries. During the camp, while 17 beneficiaries submitted loan applications for setting up of individual enterprises, 12 others got themselves enlisted for skill training.



## **HEALTH CAMP - TELANGANA**

A free heath check-up for the shelter residents was organised by the District Medical Health Office at Nizamabad on July 10, 2019. Free medicines including supplements for nutritional deficiencies were also distributed to the residents.



## WORKSHOP ON BRANDING OF SHG PRODUCTS – ANDHRA PRADESH

On July 15, 2019 a workshop on `Branding of SHG products" was organized at Guntur where 207 SHG members/entrepreneurs participated. Technical experts from East FX Technical Consultancy interacted and sensitised the participants on branding concepts and online marketing of SHG products.
