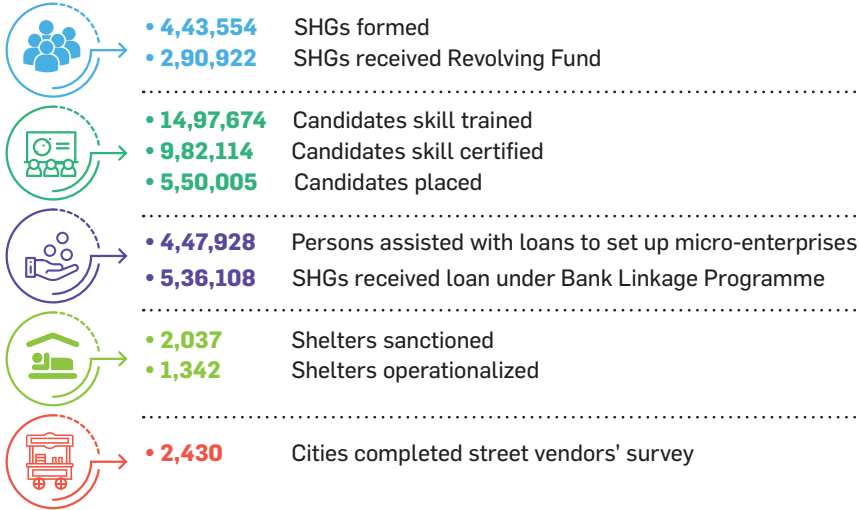

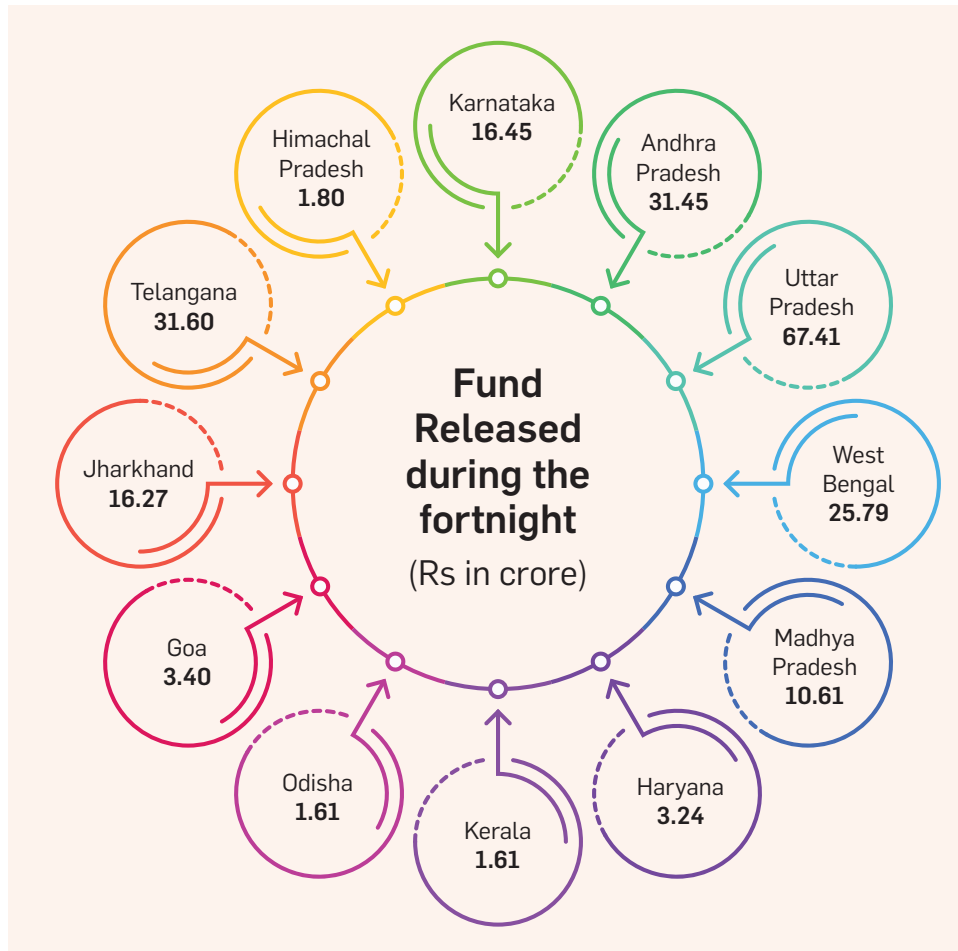

SKOCH Governance Gold Award conferred

On August 29, 2019, DAY-NULM was conferred with the prestigious SKOCH Governance Gold Award for its Portal for Affordable Credit and Interest Subvention Access (PAiSA) in a function held at the Constitution Club of India, New Delhi. PAiSA portal offers end to end online solution for processing, payment, monitoring and tracking of interest subvention claims from banks on a monthly basis. As of now, 28 States/UTs and 74 Banks including 21 Public Sector Banks, 18 Private Banks and 35 Regional Rural Banks have been on-boarded on the portal. Till now approximately 1.50 lakh beneficiaries have been paid about Rs. 27 Cr. as interest subvention through the portal.



Workshops on Swasth SHG Pariwar- 100 Days Impact initiative held:

One day sensitization workshops on Swasth SHG Pariwar- 100 Days Impact Initiative were organized in Andhra Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Punjab, Assam, Bihar, Karnataka, Mizoram and Meghalaya. The workshops were participated by functionaries of NULM, National Health Mission, Women and Child Development and Urban Local Bodies. The purpose of workshops was to sensitise the participants on linking of eligible SHG households with the Ayushman Bharat and POSHAN Abhiyaan, and also on organizing health check-up for SHG members and their families, by October 2, 2019.



HEALTH CAMPS ORGANISED

To improve access of SHG women and their families to quality healthcare under Swasth SHG Parivar initiative, free health check-up camps were conducted in various States/UTs viz. Haryana, Assam, Andhra Pradesh, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Bihar, Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, Karnataka and Manipur. SHG family members were provided free medical consultations & nutrition advice during the camps.

CITY LIVELIHOOD CENTRE INAUGURATED IN ASSAM

City Livelihood Centre at Tezpur was inaugurated by Hon'ble Minister, Urban Development, Assam on August 18, 2019. This is the fourth CLC in the state becoming functional. The CLC will work as a bridge for facilitating linkage for the urban poor with appropriate livelihood opportunities on the one hand, and facilitating access to service needs of urban citizens on the other.



JOB FAIR FOR DIFFERENTLY-ABLED ORGANISED IN TAMIL NADU

A job fair was organized for differently-abled candidates on August 25, 2019 at Loyola College, Tamil Nadu. About 5,500 candidates were interviewed by 134 companies/firms for job opportunities in various Sectors viz. IT, ITES, Retail, Manufacturing, Hospitality & Health Care. A total of 1,967 candidates were shortlisted and 375 received offer letters during the event.

AWARENESS PROGRAMME FOR STREET VENDORS ORGANISED IN CHANDIGARH

An awareness and sensitization programme for the registered street vendors was organised jointly by Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh and Department of Community Medicine SPH, PGIMER, Chandigarh on August 29, 2019. The objective of the programme was to sensitise the street vendors on food safety, hygiene, cleanliness, etc. More than 50 street food vendors participated in the programme. Smart food cart designed with various food safety features was also inaugurated during the event.



SENSITISATION WORKSHOP ON POSHAN ABHIYAN ORGANISED IN MAHARASHTRA

A sensitisation workshop on Poshan Abhiyan was organised for the SHG members at Nandurbar. Over 1,000 participants including SHG women and their family members attended the health camp which provided free medical check-up and nutritional advice. Revolving Fund to 100 SHGs and 6 ALFs was also disbursed during the event.



HON'BLE GOVERNOR, UP, INTERACTS WITH SHG MEMBERS

On August 26, 2019, the Hon'ble Governor, Uttar Pradesh, Smt. Anandiben Patel interacted with members of Self Help Groups & Area Level Federations of Lucknow. During the interaction, the SHG members displayed their handicrafts, handlooms and home decor products. The Hon'ble Governor expressed happiness over the initiatives and experiences of ALF members, especially on variety of livelihoods activities undertaken by the SHGs in slums.



SPECIAL AADHAR ENROLMENT CAMPS FOR SHELTER INMATES IN TAMIL NADU

On August 24 & 31, 2019, the Greater Chennai Corporation (GCC) organised exclusive Aadhar camps in 38 shelters to enroll and provide Aadhaar cards to the shelter residents. A total of 128 residents benefitted during the camps. The GCC, through the respective SMAs, is facilitating homeless in receiving Aadhaar Cards, opening of bank accounts and their enrolment in various welfare schemes of the government.
