REVIEW OF FLAGSHIP URBAN MISSIONS IN TELANGANA

On March 6, 2021, Shri Durga Shanker Mishra, Secretary, HUA reviewed the progress of various urban missions and schemes in Telangana including Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM) and the Prime Minister Street Vendor's AtmaNirbhar Nidhi (PM SVANidhi) in a meeting held at Hyderabad. Secretary, HUA complimented the State government for the progress made in the implementation of PM SVANIDHI and also acknowledged achievements of the state in implementation of DAY-NULM. Shri Somesh Kumar, Chief Secretary, Telangana State, Shri Sanjay Kumar, Joint Secretary, MoHUA & Mission Director, NULM, and other senior officers of the state attended the review meeting.





MISSION DIRECTOR REVIEWS PROGRESS OF PM SVANIDHI SCHEME

Shri. Sanjay Kumar, Joint Secretary, MoHUA & Mission Director, NULM visited State Bank of India, Chandrayangutta branch, and Union Bank of India, Ramanthapur branch in Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation. Shri Sanjay Kumar inspected the process of mobilization of Street Vendors and the process followed by the banks in sanction and disbursement of loans. During the visit, Street Vendors were sensitized on various benefits available under the scheme including those for undertaking digital transactions and making timely repayments.



SPECIAL LOAN CAMPS FOR STREET VENDORS ORGANISED

Special camps were organized in various bank branches across the country to sanction and disburse loans under PM SVANidhi. Advisories were already issued to the banks by the Ministry of Finance and to the States/UTs by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs to work exclusively on 6th and 13th March 2021 for addressing the gaps by organising special camps. The camps were organised in various lending institutions across the cities. ULBs mobilised the eligible beneficiaries to the camps and facilitated documentation. In the camps, the Street Vendors were sensitized regarding the benefits of the scheme, digital transactions, and timely repayment of EMI.

UTTAR PRADESH ORGANISED A SPECIAL LOAN DISBURSEMENT DRIVE

The state of Uttar Pradesh organized a week-long special drive from March 1-6, 2021 for sanction and disbursement of loans to PM SVANidhi beneficiaries in various bank branches. Shri Ashutosh Tandon, Hon'ble Minister, Urban Development, Overall Urban Development, Urban Employment and Poverty Alleviation, Uttar Pradesh launched the campaign on March 1, 2021 virtually and also interacted with PM SVANidhi beneficiaries.





REVIEW OF IMPLEMENTATION OF PM SVANIDHI

On March 12, 2021 a meeting (Video Conference) to review implementation of PM SVANidhi in States/UTs was held co-chaired by Additional Secretary, DFS and Joint Secretary, MoHUA. The meeting was attended by State Mission Directors of NULM, representatives of Banks, and Municipal Commissioners. States/UTs and banks were advised to take up steps for early sanction and disbursement of all pending loan applications under PM SVANidhi. ULBs were advised to facilitate timely completion of documentation requirements in coordination with Lending Institutions for early disbursal of loans to street vendors.

REVIEW OF PROGRESS OF PM SVANIDHI IN UTTAR PRADESH

On March 13, 2021, Sri. Sanjay Kumar, Joint Secretary, MoHUA& Mission Director, NULM visited the BOI branch of Raheem Nagar and Gramin Bank branch of Aryavart at Gomtinagar, Lucknow Municipal Corporation of Uttar Pradesh. Shri Sanjay Kumar visited the online registration camp, inspected the process of mobilization of Street Vendors and also the process followed by banks for sanction and disbursement of loans. During the visit, Street Vendors were sensitized regarding the benefits of the scheme, digital transactions, and timely repayment of EMI.





EIGHTH MEETING OF EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE. DAY-NULM HELD

The 8th meeting of the Executive Committee of DAY-NULM was held on March 8, 2021 under the Chairmanship of Shri Durga Shanker Mishra, Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs. The decisions/recommendations by the EC inter-alia included Skill Training of 1 lakh construction workers during 2021-22 as an I & SP project under the skilling framework of EST&P; a special sub-scheme for enabling 1st bank linkages of uncovered SHGs; Capping the interest subsidy for rate of interest over and above 7% at a maximum of 7% under SEP; and comprehensive restructuring of Management Information System(MIS) for DAY-NULM.

INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY CELEBRATED

International Women's Day was celebrated in various ULBs across the country. The theme this year has been Women in leadership: Achieving an equal future in a COVID-19 world'. On March 8, 2021, Self Help Groups and their federations organised awareness rallies on the theme. The campaign highlighted the role of women in development and underscored the importance of providing quality opportunities for developing and demonstrating their leadership qualities.





SHELTERS FOR URBAN HOMELESS GET ISO TAG

Seven Shelters for Urban Homeless located in Bhubaneswar, Odisha received certification for ISO 9001:2015 standards for Quality Management System. The shelters are equipped with all basic amenities for the urban homeless. So far, 19 SUHs in Odisha got ISO tag including the Socio Equity Centre. The state is contemplating to enrich and provide the shelters with all requirements so that all the 37 functional Shelters receive the ISO tag.
