In efforts to empower urban SHG women involved in the food processing sector, Jajpur Municipality, Odisha has taken a significant step by opening an outlet exclusively dedicated to showcasing and selling their handmade food products. This initiative provides a much-needed platform for SHG members to exhibit their culinary skills and entrepreneurial spirit. The members have also undergone comprehensive training in micro food processing to ensure their skills are honed to perfection. These women produce various delectable goods, including Badi, Papads, Arisha Pitha, Ladoos, Fried Chana, Mixture, Bhujias, Pakodas, Cakes, and many more. Under the Prime Minister's Formalization of Micro Food Enterprises (PMFME) scheme SHGs members of

DAY-NULM are provided seed capital, handholding support for their food processing enterprise. A total of 8 SHGs of the Swayam Sidha Area Level Federation have received seed capital support of ₹29.80 lakhs under PMFME.

National Level Progress Review Meeting of SVANidhi Se Samriddhi

Shri Rahul Kapoor, Mission Director & Joint Secretary, PM SVANidhi chaired a review meeting with all the states/UTs to review the progress of socio-economic profiling of street vendors and sanctioning of the welfare schemes under SVANidhi se Samriddhi (SSS). He emphasized that this initiative provides benefits of eight welfare schemes to the street vendors and their family members through convergence with five Ministries. He urged that monthly camps of SSS, to facilitate profiling and sanction of the schemes, need to be conducted on regular basis.

Making Wealth from Fish Waste: Story of TNULM's Fish Amino Acid Producing

The incredible tale of the Kalaimagal SHG members from Chennai's Coastal District, who are turning fish waste into fish amino acid and turning garbage into treasure, is very motivating. With the help of Tamil Nadu Urban Livelihoods Mission, they received specialized training and expert advise from Agriculture department on how to produce this valuable substance. Their profession not only generates revenue but contributes greatly towards creating a green Tamil Nadu by utilizing waste products effectively.







Nitin Kakaso Patil, Panipuri Stall, (Kolhapur, Maharashtra)

Nitin used to earn a decent living by selling panipuris on his cart. However, everything changed when the pandemic hit the country. He suffered a huge financial crisis and it was difficult for him to earn his livelihood. Under PM SVANidhi, he received ₹10,000/- as working capital loan which helped him to restart the business. He received a cashback of ₹644/- for regularly conducting digital transactions. Through the earning from his revived business, he was able to pay back the entire loan amount, which helped him to avail a second loan of ₹20,000/-. He secured his family by availing insurance under PM Suraksha Beema Yojana and the PM Jeevan Jyoti Beema Yojana, which was possible because of convergence facilitated by SVANidhi Se Samriddhi.
