States Discuss Recommendations on 'Chintan Shivir- Reimagining Urban Governance and **Urban Spaces'**

The states gathered in a virtual meeting co-chaired by Shri Kunal Kumar, Joint Secretary & Mission Director - Smart Cities Mission; Shri Kuldeep Narayan, Joint Secretary & Mission Director - PMAY (U); and Shri Rahul Kapoor, Joint Secretary & Mission Director - NULM & PM SVANidhi, to discuss recommendations made by the state teams on 'Chintan Shivir' Reimagining Urban Governance and Urban Spaces.
