From the States

Himachal Pradesh: A seven days Entrepreneurship Programme Development (EDP) was organized in Punjab with association National Bank & RSETI, Solan from February, 27 to March 2019. The 5, programme was inaugurated by Shri Virendra Kashyap, Hon'ble Member Parliament. A total of 30 candidates were imparted skills on business establishment and strategy, marketing, branding, accounts management and communication skills.

Tamil Nadu: On March 6 2019 the Chennai Municipal Corporation's Health Wing initiated a rescue drive to rehabilitate homeless people. Rescue vans were engaged to locate and bring the homeless to the shelters run by the Corporation. Under the drive, 23 homeless, from the streets of Marina beach, were rescued and moved to the shelters.

Andhra Pradesh: Smt. Shobha, a member of Nissi SHG, who has been successfully running Swapnika Boutique -cum-Institute of fashion technology & Printing Unit, was conferred upon with best entrepreneur award by Hon'ble Chief Minister. She has employed 36 other women in her unit enabling them also to earn their livelihoods.

Gujarat: On March 2, 2019, Project Sanctioning Committee of **GULM** sanctioned 24 proposals for construction of new shelters. The newly sanctioned shelters will accommodate 2,482 homeless in 9 ULBs.

Rajasthan: For the entrepreneurs and SHG members, an EDP training was organized in collaboration with Bank of Baroda & RSETI, from March 7-12, 2019. A total of 28 beneficiaries were provided training on basic entrepreneurial skill to run business, related soft skill & accounting.

International Women's Day- Initiatives of States

Uttar Pradesh: Seven Self Help Groups participated in the Women Livelihoods National Meet, 2019 held on March 8, 2019 at the Deendayal Hastakala Sankul in Varanasi. The event, organized on the occasion of International Women's' Day, was among others attended by Shri Narendra Modi, Hon'ble Prime Minister of India. The SHG members displayed and sold their products handloom, viz. handicraft, home decor products, artificial jewelleries etc.

Maharashtra: On International Women's Day, around 2,000 women Self Help Group members participated in Mahila Mela organized at Bhandara. During the Mela, 7 SHGs were given revolving fund, 16 SHGs & 7 individual entrepreneurs were provided the bank loans and candidates trained under the Skill India Mission were given their certificates



Assam: On the occasion of International Women's Day on March 8, 2019 the State Urban Livelihoods Mission distributed revolving fund of Rs. 12.40 Cr. to the eligible Self Help Groups.
